Three Peaks Challenge

Are you up to the challenge?

Climb the highest mountains in Scotland (*Ben Nevis*), England (*Scafell Pike*) and Wales (*Snowdon*), a total of over 450 miles driving, 24 miles trekking, and over 10,000 feet of climbing – all within a 24 hour period.

The Challenge:

After a safety briefing and kit check at Fort William, your team will climb to the summit of Ben Nevis, then return to Glen Nevis Visitor Centre for the long drive to Wasdale, Cumbria, for your climb up Scafell Pike. Descend back to Wasdale, and drive into Snowdonia for your final push – to reach the summit of Snowdon. Return to Llanberis for buffet, medals, certificates, and a well earned drink..!

The Mountains:

- Ben Nevis, Highland, 1344 metres – 10 mile trek
- Scafell Pike, Lake District, 978 metres – 5 mile trek
- Snowdon, Snowdonia, 1085 metres – 9 mile trek

Your Team:

Should consist of 4-8 fit walkers (depending upon event) including at least one competent navigator, and 2 dedicated drivers who will take no part in the trekking. You will need transport (minibus or MPV), fuel, walking equipment, food and accommodation before and/or after the challenge, bags of enthusiasm and a sense of humour.

Fundraising:

Pay one simple, fixed, team entry fee with no extra fundraising commitment. Raise funds for any charity or good cause you choose, or none at all..! Simple online entry system with £149 deposit.
